**Musicambia** (**''music''+''change''**) helps people in prison write, play, and perform music, cultivating collaborative communities that nurture everyone involved. Musicambia's Flagship Program, which began at Sing Sing Correctional Facility in 2014, meets every other weekend from September to June. Thirty participants attend over four hours of classes, fostering teamwork, empathy, and responsibility to themselves and fellow students. Musicambia also operates programs at Bedford Hills in New York, Kansas, and California, annually reaching 125 incarcerated participants and audiences of 220 incarcerated people at concerts.
